

# GDP per capita


#### **Relative to OECD. Index. OECD = 100**



#### **Percentage of GDP**





Petroleum revenues and return on investment




# A large fund

In billions of NOK (left-hand scale). Percentage of GDP (right-hand scale)




### A fund owned by the Norwegian people Governance model




## **A countercyclical investor**

## International real interest rates<sup>1)</sup>


