




Oil wealth has brought strong rise in prosperity











The Government Pension Fund Global and the fiscal rule




Projected size of the oil fund¹⁾

As a percentage of trend GDP for mainland Norway




- 1) Deviation from trend

The size of Norges Bank's balance sheet including the oil fund




Real exchange rate and oil price




Inflation

Moving 10-year average and variation in CPI. Percent





Key policy rate in the baseline scenario



Governance structure




Changing the regional allocation
